We endeavour to keep the school open at all times however, if we have insufficient staffing or a health and safety issue i.e. no water or heating we may need to make a decision to close the school.

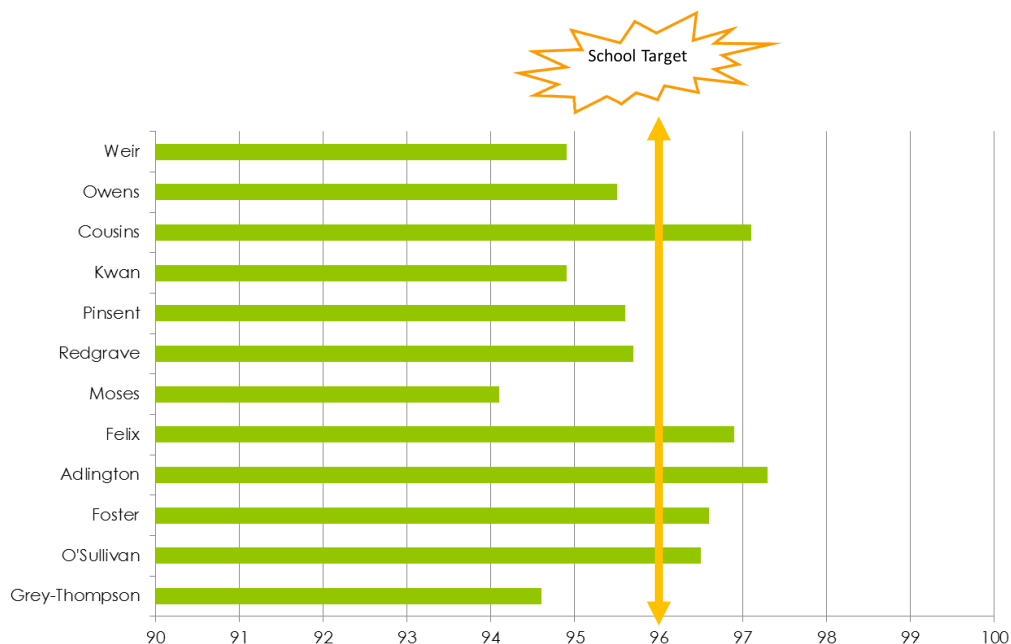
