Yea 1 trip Booklands Transport Museum

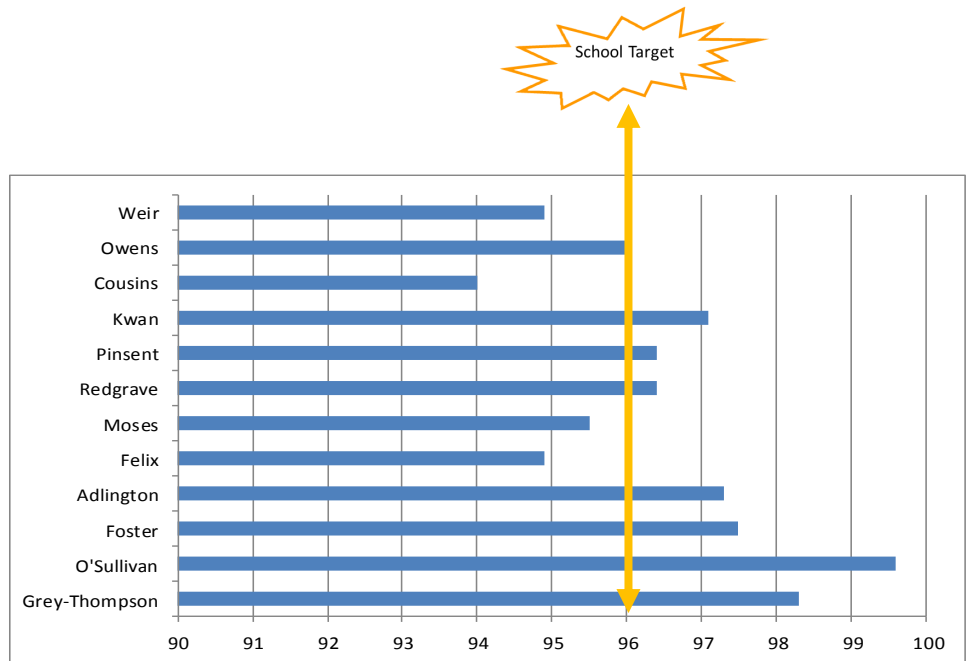

About the Walk-in Centre

The Walk-in Centre is staffed by experienced nurses and offers advice and treatment for **adults and children** with minor injuries and illnesses such as:

- Cuts and bruises
- Strains and sprains – and possible fractures
- Urinary tract infections, earache and sore throats, headaches and rashes
- Superficial burns and scalds
- Wounds requiring stitching/closure
- Bites and stings
- Minor head injuries
- Tetanus immunisation if you need one following burns and lacerations
- Minor skin and tissue infections
- Removal of foreign bodies from eyes, ears and noses

Do I have to make an appointment?

No appointment is necessary. All our patients have an initial assessment shortly after arriving at the centre. While we aim for everyone to be seen as quickly as possible, there will sometimes be situations where patients need to be treated more quickly than others.
