### **Future fundraising and events**

Along with the summer fair in July, we intend to have a spring disco and possibly a parent's only event such as a quiz night to raise funds for our children. Feedback following the Spooky disco proved that we have capacity issues. We therefore intend to split the disco into 3 with the aim of making sure everyone can attend. Our intended time slots will look something like this:

4.30pm-5.15pm – Nursery and Reception – Parents to stay with children

5.30pm-6.30pm – Years 1 & 2 - Children can be left if required

6.45pm – 8.15pm – Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 – Children to be left

We hope this will make the disco more accessible to everyone and give more room for extra tickets to be purchased for siblings. Once we have sorted the finer details and date we will update you.

We would also welcome feedback on whether a parent's only evening event would be well attended. A separate survey will be circulated for this.

We will be donating £10 to each class this term. The children, teachers and parents can decide what this will be spent on. In addition to this there will be the opportunity to 'grow' this money by fundraising yourselves. Each year group will also be allocated a week where they can organise a fundraising activity on one of the days after school (such as a cake sale). The profits of this will be split equally between the two classes in that year. It is vitally important that each class has a representative who is willing to organise these events. Dates will be circulated soon.
