


Year 1 Homework - Summer Term 2

Please pick one activity below to complete each week, so by **Monday 16th July** you will have completed **5** activities of your choice. This means 4 of the activities are not compulsory, however, they will support your learning and we think you will enjoy them so complete them if you wish!
 © Be creative with your work, you could stick in photos, maps, leaflets, drawings, work you have completed on a computer etc. Cross off the square when you have completed that piece of homework.

<p><u>PE</u> Create a fact file about your favourite sports person. Who are they? What sport do they play? What are their achievements?</p> 	<p><u>Maths/Science</u> Create a calendar showing months of the year. In which season does each month fall? Could you decorate your calendar to show what the weather is like in each month?</p> 	<p><u>PSHE</u> Create a poster showing ways to protect and care for our environment. For example, recycling, reusing and choosing biodegradable products.</p> 
<p><u>English</u> We have read lots of books this year, write a review of your favourite. What was it about? Who was it written by? Who would you recommend it to?</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>THIS ACTIVITY MUST BE CHOSEN</u></p> <p><u>Maths</u> How many ways can you make 20p? Record all the ways in your book (i.e. photos of real coins, coin rubbings, drawing around coins, number sentences).</p> 	<p><u>Maths</u> Create a schedule of your day including clock faces to show the time each event takes place. Make sure you put the events in order!</p> 
<p><u>Geography/Science</u> Research a country that experience extreme weather conditions. For example, India experiences lots of rain during monsoon season.</p> 	<p><u>PE/Music</u> Create a chant for your house (Ruby, Sapphire, Topaz or Emerald). Write it down, learn it by heart and teach your friends in time for sports day!</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Create a collage or painting showing a season of your choice - spring, summer, autumn or winter.</p> 

Daily homework: Practise your mental maths target so you can earn your gold star and move to the next challenge! Use Mathletics and Spellodrome. Recap on what we have learned in phonics by practising your spelling patterns for the week. Remember to read daily and record it in your reading record. Discuss what you have read, with an adult, to develop your comprehension skills. Practise reading and spelling your Y1 common exception words (list in spelling book).
