Task: (20 mins)

Use your knowledge of multiplying or dividing by 10 to work out the calculations below. **Remember to show**

your workings!

$$2680 \div 20 =$$

$$2680 \times 5 =$$

$$2680 \times 20 =$$

$$2680 \div 5 =$$
