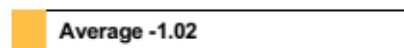

Pupils with adjusted scores = 1

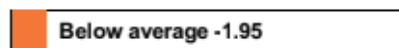

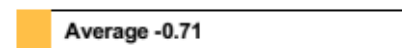

Children's progress across KS1-2 in 2018 shows a strong improvement from weak progress in 2017, when it was well below average for reading and writing and below average for mathematics.

2. Average scaled scores in reading, writing and mathematics

	Reading	Mathematics
2018	103.8	103.4
2017	101.0	101.6
2016	99.2	101.5

A score of 100 is the expected standard in both the reading and the mathematics tests at the end of Y6. Average scores in 2018 show continued improvement from 2017 and 2016 results.

3. Percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard or above in reading, writing and mathematics

	Reading	Writing	Mathematics	R, W & M
2018	67%	63%	69%	52%
2017	70%	64%	59%	48%
2016	43%	59%	50%	36%

The proportion of children reaching the expected standard in each measure has shown a strong trend of improvement over the last two years, particularly in mathematics.

4. Percentage of pupils who achieved a high level of attainment in reading, writing and mathematics

	Reading	Writing	Mathematics	R, W & M
2018	33%	17%	21%	8%
2017	4%	7%	19%	4%
2016	14%	11%	18%	4%

The proportion of children achieving a high level of attainment in each measure has again shown a strong trend of improvement over the last two years, particularly in reading.
