Converting percentages, decimals and

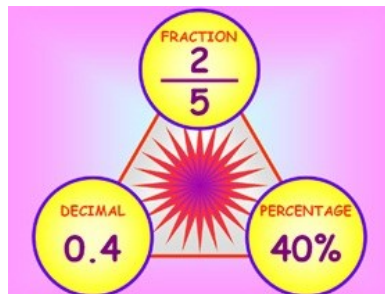
Task: (20 mins)
