- Samuel has 241 marbles at a party. He puts 8 marbles into each gift bag. How many gift bags does he fill?
- There are 38 boxes of cereal on a shelf. How many boxes on 5 shelves?
- There are 35 rows of 14 dominoes. How many dominoes are there altogether?

- Six pencils cost £1.92. Three pencils and one rubber cost £1.21. What is the cost of one rubber?
- A stack of 40 identical toy boxes is 1000cm tall. Markus takes three boxes off the top of the pile. How tall is the stack now?
- Mrs Tunnicliffe is making jam to sell at the county fair. Blackberries cost £5.50 per kg. Sugar costs 65p per kg. 15 glass jars cost £5.85. She uses 16kg of blackberries and 10kg of sugar to make 15 jars of jam. Calculate the total cost to make 15 jars of jam.
- A school orders 10 boxes of dice. Each box contains six bags of dice. Each bag contains 35 dice. How many dice does the school order in total? Please show all working out
