You could design a new building, a zoo for some animals or even a theme park you'd like to go to!</p>
<p>Go on a scavenger hunt around the house. Find something smooth, bumpy, rough, long, smelly and noisy!</p>	<p>Play 'Follow the leader' with your family. Choose a type of body percussion (tapping knees, clicking fingers, clapping hands etc. and follow rhythm body patterns.)</p>	<p>Play 'I Spy'. Say the first sound of the thing you can see and other people guess what it is. You could also find objects beginning with a particular phonic sound (s)from around your home.</p>	<p>Read a bedtime story together. Point to the words, talk about the pictures and use different voices for different characters.</p>	<p>Practise writing your name.</p>
<p>Make your bed and tidy up your toys.</p>	<p>How many star jumps can you do in 30 seconds? Can you beat your record?</p>	<p>Fill a small box or bags with 10 items. Help your child to count them into the box</p>	<p>Have fun with junk modelling making robots or vehicles or animals. Practise your cutting and sticking skills.</p>	<p>Find 5 squares around the house.</p>
