Covid-19:

Bubbles;

Children will be placed in bubbles of no more than 12 children . Where possible no changes will be made to this bubble for the week, however due to the nature of our provision and children not attending a full week, we may need to accept additional children into an existing bubble ,not exceeding the 12:1 ratio.

Drop off / Collection;

Where possible, an in / out system will be in place for drop off and collection.

Only one parent is permitted to drop off and collect, also advised where possible siblings do not attend drop off and pick up and no children older than 12 are permitted onsite. Children under 5 must be in a buggy or holding hands with an adult when collecting.

Parents will not sign in or sign out and instead use the password to handover and collect children.

Children are asked to only bring necessary personal items to clubs, (Drink, lunch, additional clothing), no toys or personal belongings.

Sports / Games;

The sports and games the children will have on offer during the holiday camps have been revised to adhere to social distancing and minimising cross contamination as much as possible.

Hand Washing;

Strict measures will be in place for the children to be able to frequently wash their hands with soap, especially upon arrival and before snack / lunchtime.

Health;

We do ask that if your child is showing any signs of feeling unwell or is experiencing any of the symptoms of Covid-19 that you do NOT bring them to Holiday Club. If a child becomes unwell during the day in our care, we will contact the parent immediately to come and collect their child.

Summer Catch Up:

To support with the Government's '**Summer of Catch Up**' message, SCL have put a lot of thought into our summer programme to include x2 literacy tasks per week and x3 numeracy tasks per week. These will be in the forms of games so as the children aren't opposed to getting involved! We are also basing our programme on 'Around the World Culture' which will be lots of fun but will also contain an educational edge to it.
