PLEASE JOIN IN WITH LEARNING

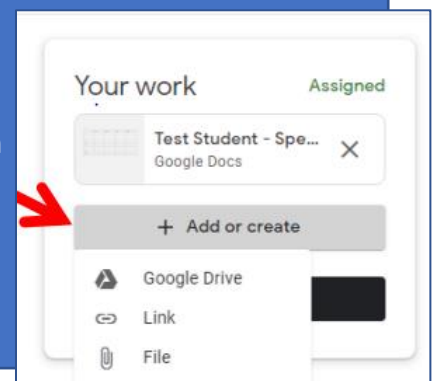

Handing In Work

When the children return to school, teachers will have a better understanding of how to target their teaching if they have had an opportunity to review the work during the lockdown period.
